
## **Munroe Elementary School Pyramid of Interventions**

Interventions are strategies designed to address specific learning (or behavior), problems as identified by diagnostic assessment data.



<u>Accommodations</u> are changes made in the way materials are presented, or in the way students respond to materials, as well as changes in setting, timing, or scheduling, with the expectation that the student will reach the standard set for all students.

Supplemental small group interventions are provided to each student whose performance level and rate of progress are behind that of peers. Students receive targeted specialized instruction that is more intensive. This instruction can be done by the general education teacher or a specialist.

## **Tier II Interventions**

Instructional interventions or enhanced instruction for all students begins in the general education classroom. Universal screening and universal interventions occur at this level.
